Building Partnerships Before an Emergency

When disasters occur, established partnerships, throughout the public and private sectors, are critical to an effective response. A typical example is a shelter hub plan in which schools, houses of worship, voluntary organizations active in disaster (VOADs), local government and state agencies partner to provide shelter and support to disaster evacuees. Having partnerships and plans in place supports successful collaboration among all involved entities. A partnership can be formalized in written agreements, such as mutual aid agreements (MAAs), memoranda of understanding (MOUs) and memoranda of agreement (MOAs). Using VOAD core values, the Four C's—Cooperation, Communication, Coordination and Collaboration—allows for networking, education and developing operational plans while

allowing individual organizations to maintain autonomy. Mutual understanding and cooperation among the private sector, emergency management efforts and all branches of government are important in building strong relationships.
