



COVID-19 Rapid Test Courses & Resources

[preparingtexas.org] BinaxNOW, CUE, and CareStart Courses

In order to take any of the rapid test courses (BinaxNOW, CUE, or CareStart), you'll need to create an account on preparingtexas.org. Instructions on creating an account and taking a course can be found on page 4 of this document titled 'How to Access Rapid Test Courses'.

Please note that preparingtexas.org is only for viewing the modules and taking the exam. You will NOT use this website to submit test results.

[app.txrapidtest.org] TXRapidTest (used during testing)

app.txrapidtest.org is the app used during the testing process to conduct the COVID-19 rapid test and report the results. Once you have completed a rapid test course in preparingtexas.org, you will be able to use this app within an hour of passing your exam.

Test Coordinator Responsibilities

Individuals who successfully complete the [Abbott BinaxNOW Ag Card](#) course receive login information for the testing application at <https://app.txrapidtest.org>. The registration process may take up to twelve hours before it is active. You will need this APP to report the results from each test.

1. Log in to preparingtexas.org

Visit preparingtexas.org. **If you have an account**, click the blue 'Log In' text in the top left. Enter your username and password, then click 'Log In'.

If you don't have an account, click the blue 'Create Account' text in the top left. Follow the prompts to create your account. [Click here for our guide on creating an account.](#)

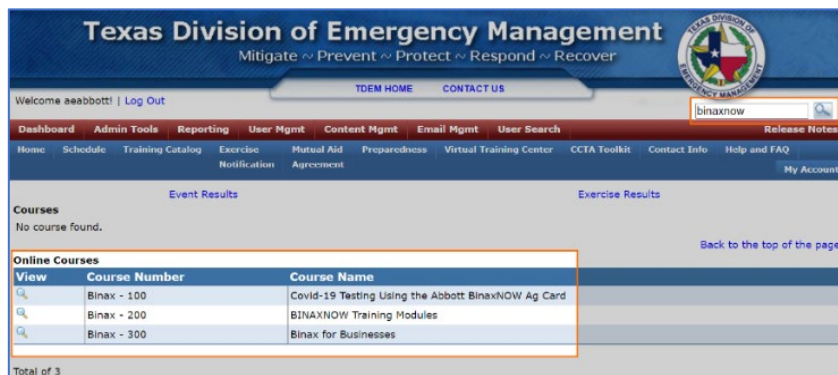


2. Enroll in the rapid test course

2. **View the admin video:** Click 'Binax Now Admin video' and watch the video (this is for BinaxNOW only)
3. **Take the exam:** Click 'Launch Module' on the row for the online exam and follow the prompts on the screen.

4. (Optional) Download your certificate

Upon passing the exam, your certificate will be generated and automatically uploaded to your profile. You will not receive a copy via email; however, you can retrieve it manually.


After you've logged on to preparingtexas.org, click 'My Account' in the top right to access your profile. Scroll down until you see 'Completed Online Courses'. You should see the rapid test course you took listed. Under the 'Certificate' column, click 'View' to open the certificate in a new window and then download it.



5. Create your app.txrapidtest.org profile

As soon as you have passed the exam, you are eligible to create your testing account on app.txrapidtest.org. **You do not need to wait for an activation email!** Please note that this account is *not* the same account as your preparingtexas.org account, so you will need to set a new password for this one.

Visit app.txrapidtest.org and click 'Forgot Password or First Login?'.
